Nicole Gordon Faces Multiple Charges Is Suspended From Position As CHS Teacher

The Canton community was stunned by news of the arrest of Canton High School teacher Nicole Gordon, who was charged with tampering with evidence at a crime scene, obstructed administration of law enforcement function, possession of drug paraphernalia, and endangering the welfare of a child.

Ms. Gordon, 35, has been placed on administrative leave from her position as a reading specialist teacher at CHS.

Blood Analysis, April 9

Once again, the Canton Lions Club will be bringing the AMBA wellness program annual blood analysis to Canton.

The program will visit Canton Elementary School on April 9 from 6 am to 10 am.

Call 1-800-234-8888. Operators are available Monday to Friday, 8:30 am - 5:00 pm. Please have your doctor's name and address available when you call. Personal physician authorization is required.

The tests require a fast of several hours, so as always the Lions will be making breakfast, so folks can buy a meal to eat after the tests. Don't forget, the breakfast is open to the general public, not only to those who take blood tests. This is a fundraiser for the Lions Club.

The AMBA Panel (\$40) includes all these tests: Coronary Disease - Cholesterol, HDL Cholesterol, Cholesterol/HDL ratio, Triglycerides, LDL Cholesterol Diabetes - Glucose Kidney Disease - Blood Urea Nitrogen, Creatinine, BUN/Creatinine Ratio (GFR)

Anemia- Red Blood Indices (MCV, MCH, MCHC, RDW) Hemoglobin, Hematocrit, Red Blood Cell Count, White Blood Cell Count

Liver Disease - Albumin, Globulin, Albumin/Globulin Ratio, AST, ALT, Total Bilirubin, Total Protein, Alkaline Phosphatase

Other Tests - Calcium, Chloride, Potassium, Sodium

Other optional tests available for separate fees are Prostate Specific Antigen, TSH, Vitamin D, Hemoglobin A1C, Insure Colon Rectal Kit (A separate physician order is required for any of the optional tests.

American Legion Post 167 Morris Run Announces Scholarship

At the regular scheduled meeting of American Legion Post 167, Morris Run, the members approved funding scholarships for the 2015-2016 school year totaling \$50,000.

Since North Penn has closed and students moved to Liberty and Mansfield Schools they will receive \$15,000 each and Canton and Troy \$10,000 each.

The money is to be divided into individual scholarships which should include both four year colleges and two year technical or trade schools.

The selection of the students is up to the individual schools. The Legion only requires that it be based on merit, need, and a display of patriotism.

They also require that they be notified as to who received the scholarships and what their future plans are.
